Available in mirror or coloured glass finishes our Bifold doors come in a variety of frame colour options giving numerous colour and style combinations.

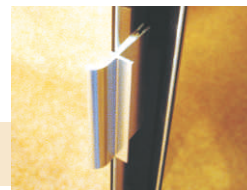
Bifold Doors;

1. require less space than conventional swing-out doors.
2. feature our offset pivot action giving better access.
3. facilitating in a smooth, quiet and consistent operation.
4. include our unique edge-guard frame design.
5. are built for a lifetime of satisfaction.

All our Bifold doors feature the edge-guard frame design which protects the panel insert without sacrificing the frameless design of the door. Frame choices are either steel frames available in Burnished Gold, Brilliant White, Vanilla, Antique Gold, Matt Black and Arctic Silver or aluminium frames available in either Chrome or Brass finishes. Polished edge mirror or coloured glass is supplied as standard however Bevelled edge options are available at additional cost and manufacturing time. The offset pivot action not only allows ease of use but provides a smooth and quiet operation as well as facilitating excellent internal access by allowing the door to fold back beyond 90 degrees when fully opened.

5. are built for a lifetime of satisfaction.

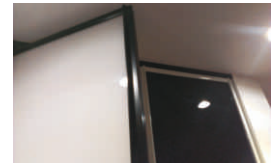
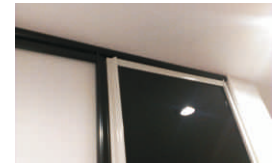

Easy door adjustment via lower door jamb, pivot locator and internal integrated adjustment device

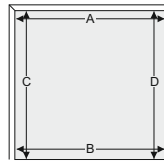


Easy door installation via upper sprung pivot retaining device and easy adjustment from pivot locator bracket



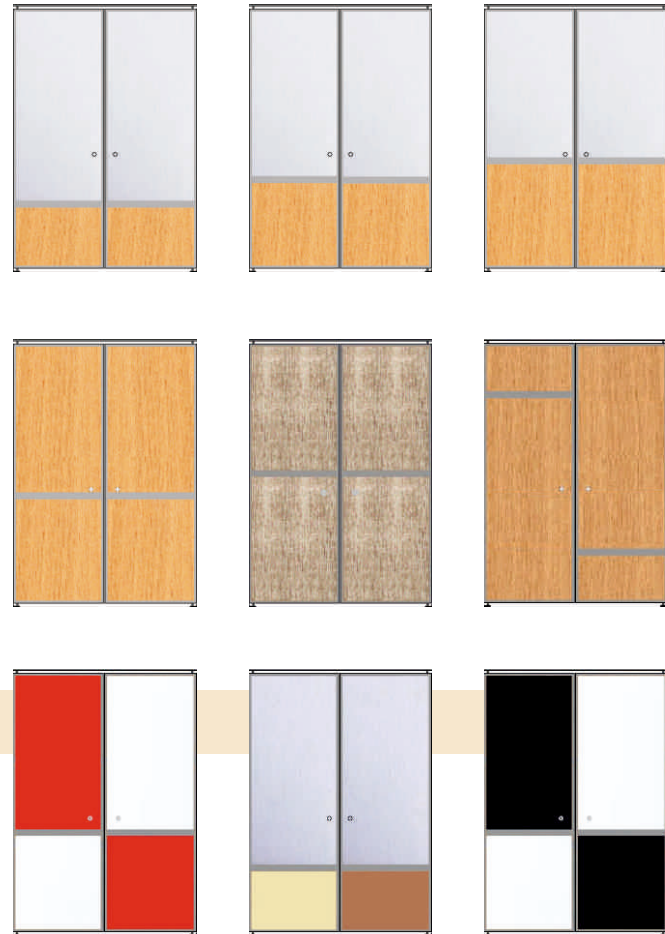

Bavarian Beech Panel



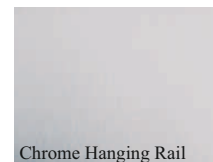

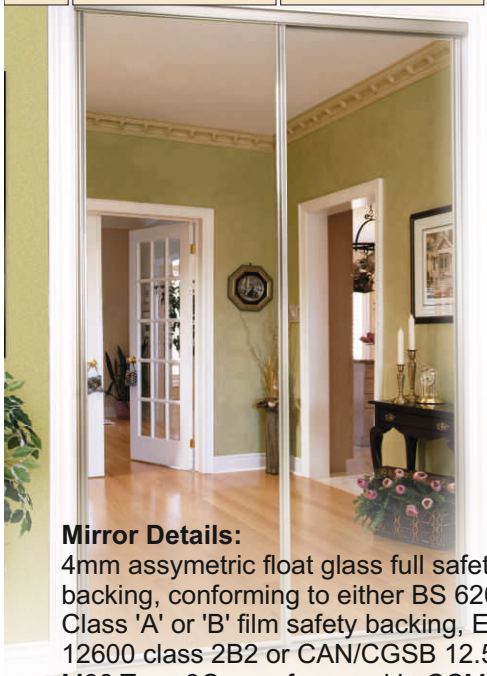


Brass Hanging Rail

Mirror Details:

4mm assymetric float glass full safety backing, conforming to either BS 6206 Class 'A' or 'B' film safety backing, EN 12600 class 2B2 or CAN/CGSB 12.5 M86 Type 3C as referenced in CCMC #12522-L & ANSI Z-97.1 and 16CFR Part 1201

Coloured Glass Details:

4mm assymetric float glass coated with environmentally friendly moisture resistant paint complying with EN 12600. Full polycarbonate film safety backing, conforming to RoHS Directive 2002/95/EC safety backing regulations.

Steel Framework Details:

Cold rolled steel (All frame colours except Chrome & Brass aluminium). Stove enamelled finish on frame finishes as listed under Series 3275A1/3275A2/3275B1/8000A/8000B/4500A. Woodgrain effect laminate finish on frame finishes as listed under Series 3275B2/4500B.

Aluminium Framework Details:

Cold rolled aluminium (Chrome & Brass aluminium finish only). Shiny Chrome or Brass effect finish on frame finishes as listed under Series 3275D1/4500D/8000D.

Note:- Series 3275B2 bottom tracking will be Series 3275A1/3275A2 and not a woodgrain effect laminate finish, 4500B top tracking will be Series 4500A and not a woodgrain effect laminate finish.

8mm/18mm Board Details:

Low formaldehyde, 8mm / 18mm thick HDPB (High Density Particle Board) melamine covered in various decors.

Edging Tape Details:

0.8mm PVC edging to match appropriate board decor.

Hanging Rail Details:

30mm x 15mm x 0.7mm oval steel tube, available in either Brass or Chrome upto 3000mm in length.

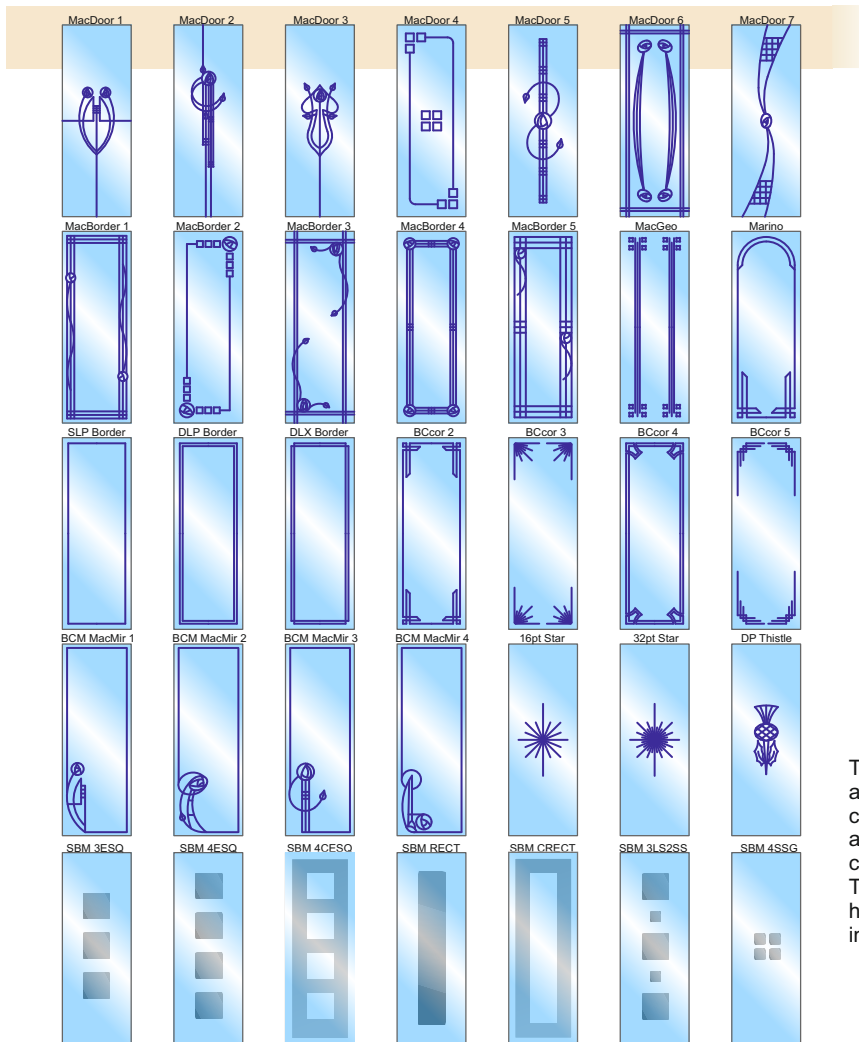

Sandblasted (Frosted) Mirror / Coloured Glass

This process leaves the sheet of mirror or coloured glass with a matt, almost obscure finish and a very fine texture. With popular designs comprising of three or four vertical squares, alternating large rectangles and small squares or can be as simple as a group of four small squares clustered together in the centre of the mirror or coloured glass. To add an extra dimension to this, each of the Sandblasted shapes can have a Brilliant Cut border added to it, this creates a fantastic visual impact to the overall door.

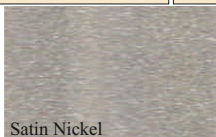

Mirrors & Frosted Mirrors

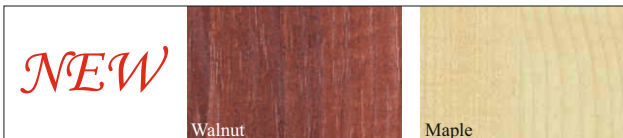

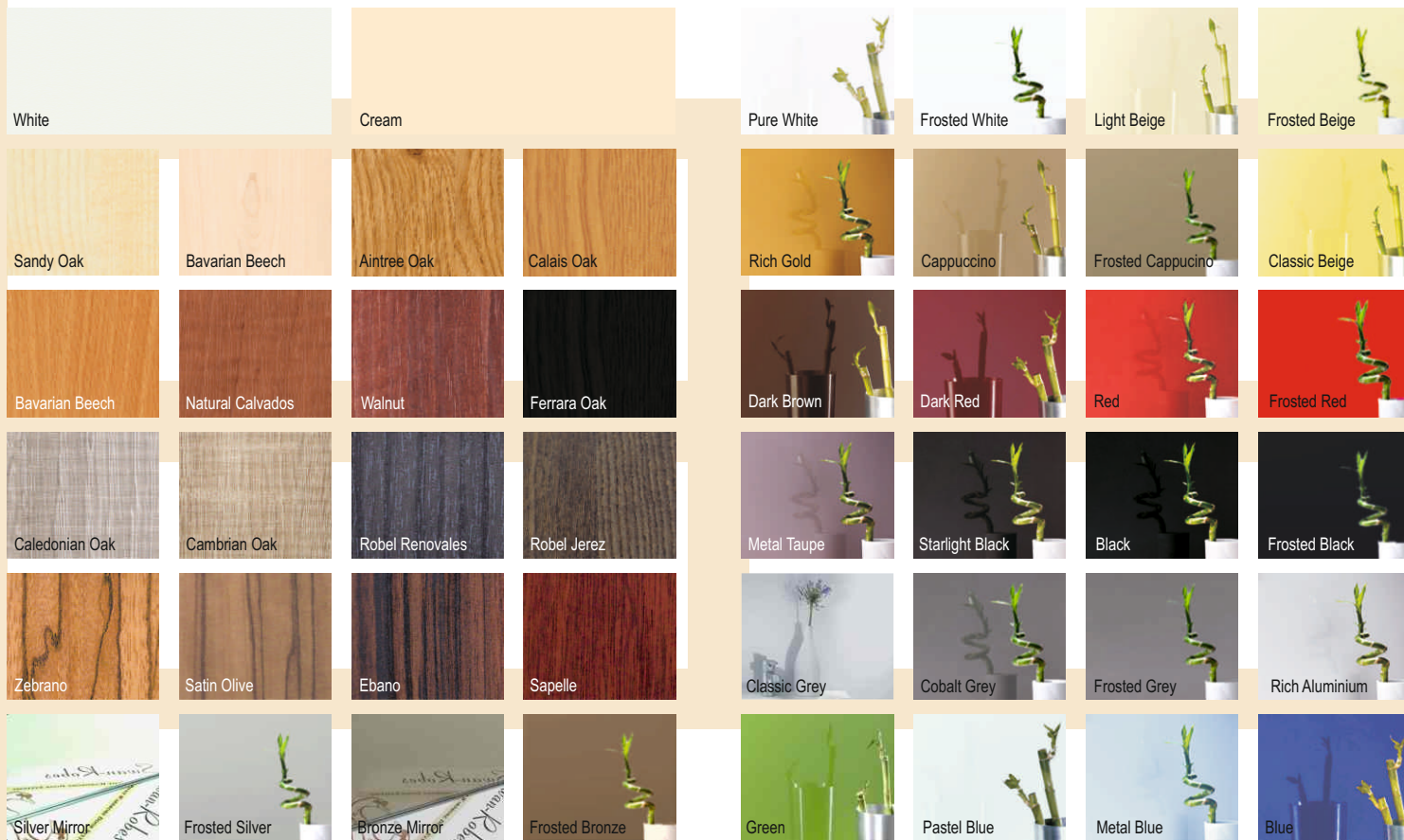
Coloured Glass & Frosted Coloured Glass

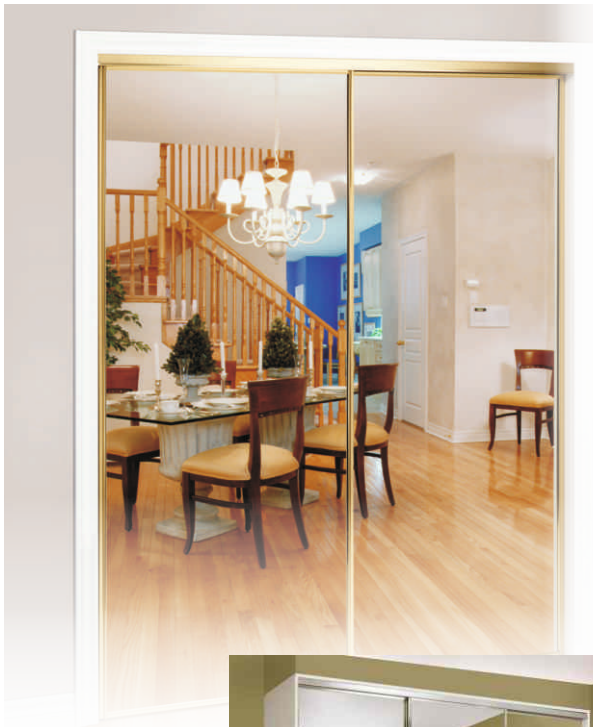
Choices

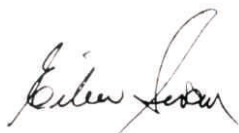
